CROSSING THE VALL D'ALBAIDA

The Vall d'Albaida crossing can be done at any time of the year, it has hardly any impact on the natural environment, as it circulates on public and open roads, avoiding paths or passing through those places of greater fragility or with some kind of protection. For a mid-level cyclist, five stages are recommended, although it can be done in more or less time depending on the days available or the physical level of each one. In the case of the use of an electric bicycle, the distance between stages allows the batteries to be recharged at the end of each always that the eco assistance position is used. A series of eight thematic routes start from the crossing through places of special interest that allow to expand the general route, including in some cases variants to the general route and alternative routes. The Vall d'Albaida is an immense natural region of great environmental quality, with high levels of administrative protection (up to one third of its territory) where humans have not intervened drastically or irreversibly in many places, and where the society is increasingly aware and committed to its environment. Traveling by bike is one of the healthiest ways to get to know our country in the context of sustainable tourism. The beauty of the surroundings and the magnificence of the landscape, together with the towns and people of the Vall d'Albaida, definitely deserve a few days to discover it.

The paths along which the great cycling route of the Vall d'Albaida runs are traditionally tracks of circulation, forest tracks, agricultural paths and ancient paths that have served throughout history to unite towns, farmhouses and agricultural properties.

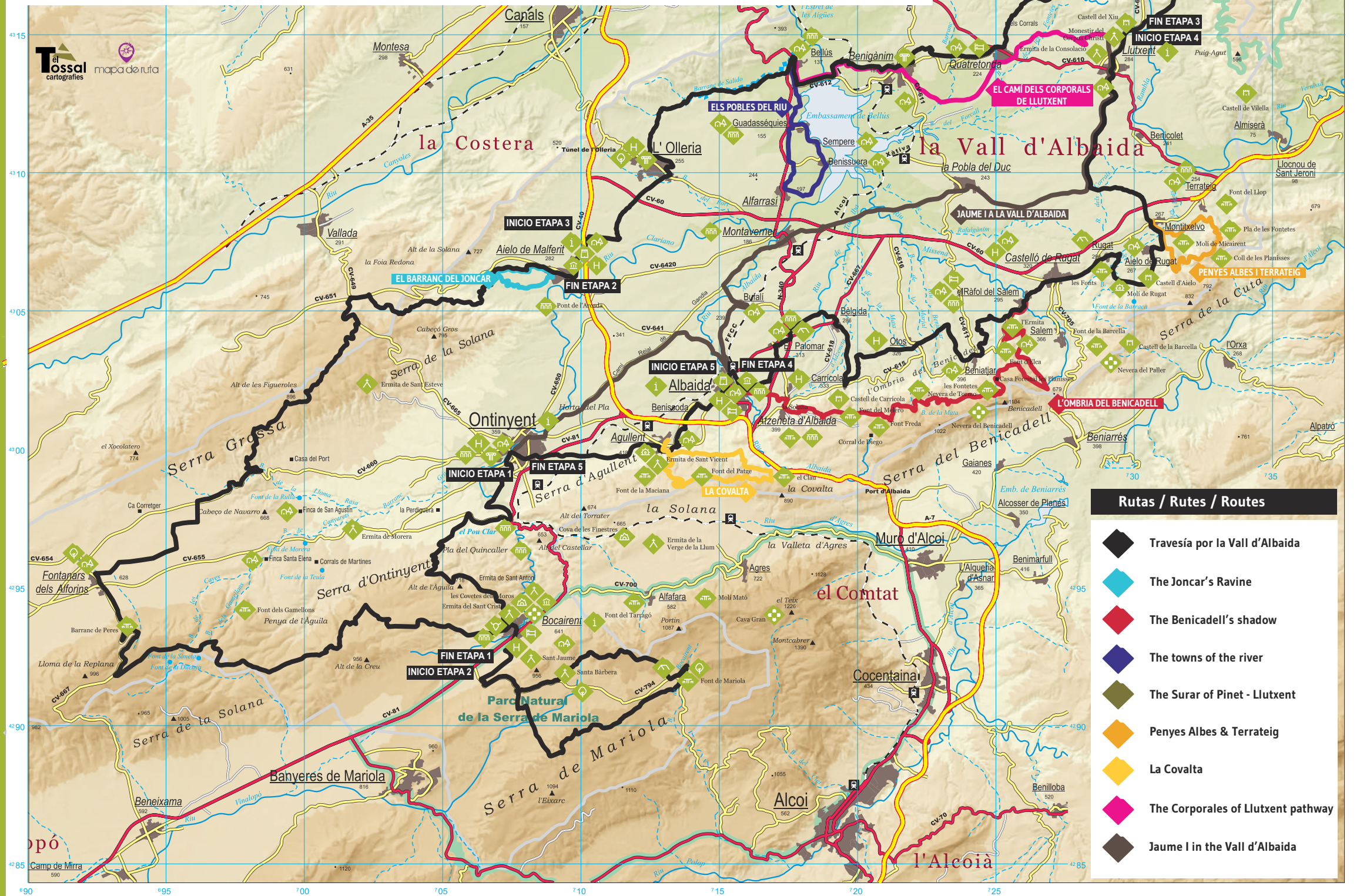
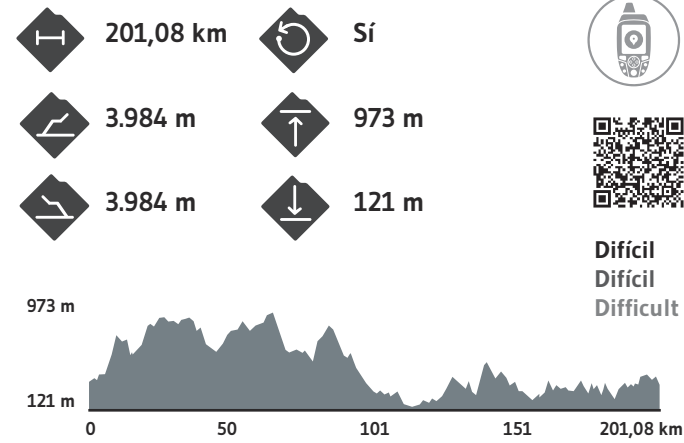

The Vall d'Albaida Cycle Tour is a 201 km long and 4667 m accumulated vertical drop designed for cycling and which runs through the Vall d'Albaida region in stages. The tour runs through places of greater scenic and cultural interest, as well as through the urban centers of a large part of the towns. It has hardly any technical difficulty, and each one can adapt it to their physical capacity and their available days. The different accommodation possibilities at the end of each stage allow you to discover in depth a fascinating territory, with friendly people who are open to visitors.
